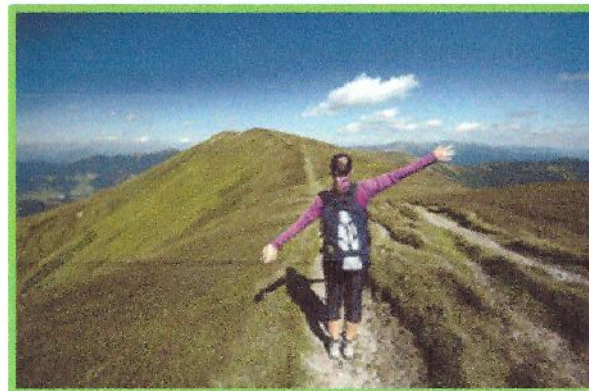

Why Keep It Moving?

Keep It Moving was born out of the tragic loss of Zane Mandel-Michalak on September 4, 2017. Our family wants to keep Zane's playful, bright spirit alive.



Our community loses too many young people each year to opioid overdose. Keep It Moving works to reduce the number of people who die from accidental overdose by offering access to Narcan, the life-saving medication that reverses an opioid overdose.

We know that nature answers the call for restless spirit that lives in all of us.



Keep It Moving offers young people the opportunity to attend nature camps, to participate in wilderness adventures and activities like skateboarding or snowboarding lessons, that may be out of reach because of financial constraints.

Keep It Moving subsidizes costs for activities and programs for young people who are financially compromised. Those in need are referred from schools (nurses, teachers, social workers), parents or the young people themselves.



Keep It Moving also provides On the Spot Narcan training, a concrete tool to save lives. We provide trainings in small groups or individual settings.
